How to Use Power Prayers

As people have discovered, speaking affirmations or making declarations of truth brings a change of mind, heart and attitude. In the case of bible verses, I think it even goes beyond the mental shift to a spiritual awakening. When you speak the holy word of God, you let loose the power of God Himself. We pray with faith words. We speak to mountains to move. We acknowledge God's truth, although we may not see it alive in our lives yet, I believe He never lies so it will come to pass if we do not stop speaking.

We are intentionally agreeing with God that His word is true and we live by every word from the mouth of God.

1. Print them or copy and put them on your phone or iPad.
2. Read them out loud, at least once each day, preferable twice-in the morning and at bedtime.
3. Read them every day for the first month, then as needed.

SECTION 1

Power Prayers

Speak. Believe. Receive.

13. I am from God and have overcome the ones against Jesus, for He who is in me is greater than He who is in the world.
14. I am raised up with Jesus and seated with Him in heavenly places
15. In Christ Jesus I am a daughter of God, through faith.
16. I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.
17. I have a spirit of power, love and a sound mind.

28. I was chosen by God to bear much fruit, fruit that abides. Whatever I ask the Father in Jesus' name, He gives it to me.
29. I abide in Jesus and Jesus abides in me and I bear much fruit.
30. I am supplied by God for every need according to His riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
